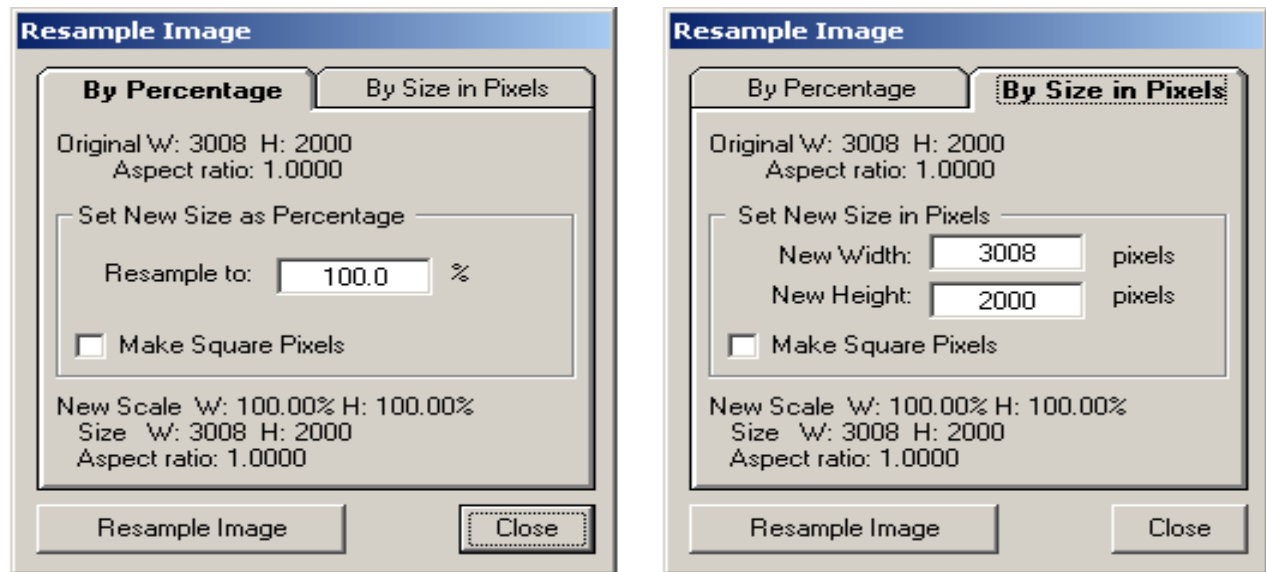


Resample

Converts an image to an image of different size.



Resampling allows you to change the size of an image. The Resample tool is set up as two tabs, one for each mode of operation:

By Percentage Tab - Allows you to specify by what percentage the image will be enlarged or reduced. It contains the following controls:

Resample to Specify a percentage. Values smaller than 100 will reduce the image size, while values larger than 100 will increase the image size.

Make Square Pixels - When clicked, the height and width of the new image will be determined by the pixel aspect ratio of the original image.

By Size in Pixels Tab - Allows you to directly specify the size of the new image. It contains the following controls:

New Width - The width in pixels of the new image to be created.

New Height - The height in pixels of the new image to be created.

Preserve Aspect Ratio - When checked, the height of the new image will be determined by the width and the pixel aspect ratio of the original image.

The buttons at the bottom of the window control the window's action.

Resample Image - Creates a new image that has been resampled.

Close - Closes without further processing.
